My name is Rudy Cordeiro and I am the Administrator of Westgate Christian School. We as a school are submitting this Summary of Services that we provide for parents needing assistance in the education of their special needs child:

Name	Description
Individualized Service Plan (ISP)	In lieu of an IEP, our school has developed an Individualized Service Plan to address the specific needs of students who have documented evidence of a special need, either through an IEP brought with them from their local school or from a medical professional. This ISP endeavors to address the needs of the student through <i>accommodations</i> in the classroom environment and testing methods as well as <i>modifications</i> to the curriculum that are more suitable for the student in preparation for graduation.
In-school and After-school Tutoring	Teachers and tutors at various levels may provide tutoring during and after school if a students' ISP recommends that they need assistance. This is available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
Third-party Contracted Assessment Provider	3 rd -party consulting is provided by Susan Blackwell, who services a number of homeschool families, in administering various tests such as the Woodcock-Johnson Assessment, 3 rd Edition or the Brigance tests. She has also overseen the administration of standardized test with accommodations and is able to provide psychological referrals and curriculum counseling to families in need.


